Brian Beckham is Head of the Internet Dispute Resolution Section in the World Intellectual Property Organization's (WIPO) Arbitration and Mediation Center; the WIPO Center manages ICANN policy matters and handled over 3,000 UDRP cases in 2016 and 17.

Prior to this Brian was Head of Legal Policy at the new gTLD consultancy *Valideus* where he led successful negotiations with ICANN on special contract provisions for "dot-brand" new TLD applicants.

During the development of ICANN's "Applicant Guidebook", Brian managed WIPO's policy input on trademark Rights Protection Mechanisms. In 2009 he led a WIPO team which successfully proposed the paperless "eUDRP" to ICANN.

Brian holds a J.D. and LL.M. (with honors) in Information Technology from the John Marshall Law School in Chicago, Illinois. Prior to joining WIPO, Brian was employed in private practice at a DC area law firm representing clients in trademark, telecommunications, and non-profit matters.
