Maggie Ramage is a Fellow, and Past President of the Chartered Institute of Trade Mark Attorneys (London). She was a member of the UK parliamentary liaison group that preceded the establishment of OHIM. In 1982 she became head of European Trade Marks for the Californian-based Raychem Corporation. She was seconded in 1987 to the Corporation's Head Office near San Francisco, where she took responsibility for world-wide trade mark affairs. Upon returning to the UK, she became Assistant Trade Marks Manager of the then Beecham Group (now part of GlaxoSmithKline) before moving to British Telecommunications plc as Trade Marks Manager. Maggie became a partner in Alexander Ramage Associates LLP in 1991, and in April 2015 joined Edwin Coe LLP as a Partner.

Her clients include start-up firms and multinationals, and range from medical practitioners to financial institutions, bath and beauty care specialists, hair care manufacturers, mobile telecom providers and food and drink providers.

As a Past President of CITMA, Maggie continues to take an active role on the governing council of CITMA, and is a member of various committees including the Executive Committee. Maggie is of course also a member of ECTA, and serves on their Professional Affairs and Membership Committees.

Maggie has been recommended in 'The Legal 500', and has chaired the International Conference of CITMA on a number of occasions. She has lectured at the International Conferences of INTA and MARQUES and has made a number of lecture tours in the United States, and has lectured meetings of professional bodies in China and Japan on more than one occasion.
