Anette has worked with IP law since 1998 in Norway with the Norwegian Patent Office and in Denmark. Anette joined Awapatent in 2000, became Partner in 2007 and has been managing the Legal team in Denmark since 2010.

Beside the Danish law degree, Anette also holds a LL.M. from Germany. Anette was admitted to the Danish Bar in 2010.

She advises clients in many industries including pharmaceuticals, food & beverages and consumer goods in relation to protection and enforcement of IP rights, marketing practises, infringement, ownership and validity disputes. She negotiates and drafts agreements concerning all kinds of IP rights and represents clients before trademark offices, the Danish courts as well as the General Court in Luxembourg.

As team manager Anette is responsible for development, finances and employees in the Danish Awapatent legal team. Anette holds a similar responsibility as Managing Partner in the law firm Awa Law Advokater.

In 2005 Anette joined ECTA and worked in the Law Committee until 2016. Anette became member of OHIM Link committee in 2010 and was Vice Chair of this committee from 2013 to 2016. Anette is member of ECTA's council as of June 2014 and was elected as Second Vice-president of ECTA in 2016.

Anette is a regular speaker at ECTA Roundtables and ECTA's annual conference as well as at the Annual Spring Meeting of the Danish Patent and Trademark Office and other events. She is a member of INTA, AIPPI, FICPI and the Danish Bar Association and was member of an expert working group under the Danish PTO focusing on the revision of the Harmonization Directive and Community Trademark Regulation.

Anette is recognized in WTR1000, MIP IP Stars and Legal 500 for her work both on enforcement and litigation as well as prosecution and strategy and was in 2017 accepted into the biographical dictionary service Kraks Blå Bog, which is comparable to Marquis Who's Who and includes people that make "lasting" contributions to Danish society.
