



ANDREJ STEC, Referendaire in the cabinet of Judge Schwarcz, General Court, LU

Mr. Stec works as a référendaire to Judge Mr. J. Schwarcz at the General Court (EU) in Luxembourg (since September 2009). During the period June 2004-September 2009, he worked as a référendaire to Judge Mr. D. Šváby. In the last months before Slovakia entered the EU (1st December 2003–May 2004), Mr. Stec worked as a legal adviser at the Delegation of the European Commission in Bratislava, Slovakia and was responsible for analyzing and supervising the process of transposition of the *acquis communautaire* into the Slovak legal system. Before joining the EU institutions, Mr. Stec worked in the law firm Allen & Overy (Bratislava, Slovakia) (September 2002 – November 2003). He studied law at the University Comenius in Bratislava, Slovakia (Mgr.) and at the University Paris XII, France (DESS). Mr. Stec gives regularly presentations on EU Trademark law, incl. at international conferences [*ERA*, Alicante, Spain (2015); *ERA*, Trier, Germany, (2016); the *1st Czech and Slovak Symposium on Trademarks and Designs*, Prague, Czech Republic, (2016); he was also the organizer and moderator of the Panel concerning the EU TM Reform at the conference “*IP – shaping the future*”, in the context of the Slovak Presidency of the Council of the European Union (Bratislava, 2016)].
